All =	anyone, no knowledge or experience needed
Intermediate =	someone with some knowledge, for patchwork this includes rotary cutting skills, ¼" seam allowance mastered and able to use a sewing machine.
Advanced =	someone with good patchwork skills

Reminder: - The class fee is due at the time of booking – It will be assumed that our terms and conditions below have been read and agreed when students book on our classes. A list of requirements for each class is available on the website approx. 2 weeks before the class, please check what you need to bring with you.

Patchwork/Needlework does require time and patience so it is unlikely you will always finish the project during the class, although you will be given all the necessary instructions to complete it at home (Open Format and Follow-on classes are also available to continue your project).

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We have 6 Janome machines (M100 QDC) for students to hire during classes, which are ideal if your machine is too heavy to carry upstairs.

The rental fee is only £5.00 per machine (for ½ or full day).

The machines are available on a first come, first serve basis.  
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Terms and Conditions

In addition to the T&Cs below please be aware that we may need to make changes to venues or cancel classes at short notice (e.g. if a tutor is ill). Where possible we will give you as much notice as possible.

If you would like to book a place on a class...

- 1) Either ring the shop or return the enclosed booking form with full payment.
- 2) We cannot guarantee your space unless you pay for your place – **bookings received without payment will be put on a waiting list and only transferred to the actual class once they are paid for.**
- 3) Should you wish to cancel - providing you give us **7 days notice** before the class, we will issue a CREDIT NOTE. It can be used against goods or classes and there is no time limit on it. However, **if you do not give us 7 days notice we will NOT BE ABLE to issue a credit note** as we would have confirmed the tutor and committed to pay their fee. We will be happy for you to find someone to take your place, but we cannot take responsibility to find someone for you.
- 4) Should WE cancel a class, a full refund (via original payment method) or class credit (if you prefer) will be given.

We will assume T&Cs have been read and agreed when you book on a class.

Lone Star with Emma Randall – Level Intermediate

Come and learn how to make this classic design without having to cut and match lots of diamonds and with minimal sewing on the bias. Depending on the size strips you use you can make it into a quilt, wall hanging or even the back of a jacket!



Dressmaking with Cathy Bonner - Level Intermediate

Come and join Cathy who can guide you through dressmaking patterns. Cathy loves the patterns from Merchant and Mills and they are great for beginners. You will need to purchase any pattern you want to use before the class. We recommend the Merchant & Mills website (merchantandmills.com) and love the Hattie and Factory dresses. If you are new to dressmaking you will probably need two sessions.



Bags, Bags, Bags! with Cathy Bonner – Level Intermediate

You can choose from a number of different bags, from Emmaline through to tote. Learning how to put zips in and easy ways to do things, these pretty bags are fun to sew, can normally be finished in a day and make fantastic gifts, perfect for friends of all ages.



Half Square Triangles with Emma Randall – Level All

Come and learn how to make fast half square triangles (HSTs) and avoid cutting and sewing on the bias. Once you've mastered the technique you can make a variety of different designs with your HST blocks and Emma will share some of these designs with you for you to choose your pattern.

Stack 'n' Whack and Kaleidoscopes with Emma Randall – Level Intermediate

Lots of different images come up when searching for Kaleidoscope Quilts along with lots of different names!

If you have wanted to make an optical illusions style quilt resembling the kaleidoscope pictures you remember from your childhood toy, then come along to this class and find out the different ways in which to make one. You will be using either 6 fabric repeats with hexagons, or 4 fabric repeats with squares or rectangles to create some stunning patterns.



Sashiko for Beginners with Daphne Morris – Level All

Sashiko is a country form of stitching from Japan. Described as fascinating, therapeutic and relaxing; come and experience an introduction to this world of both embroidery and repair.

A starter kit with fabric, thread and a needle is included in the price of this class and will be available on the day.

Bargello Twists and Turns with Emma Randall – Level Intermediate

If you've already mastered simple bargello then why not move on to twists and turns in your bargello quilts? To get the most from this class you should already have an understanding of simple Bargello or have already made a simple Bargello quilt or cushion. You will need to do preparation work at home before the class.

Great for taking to classes.

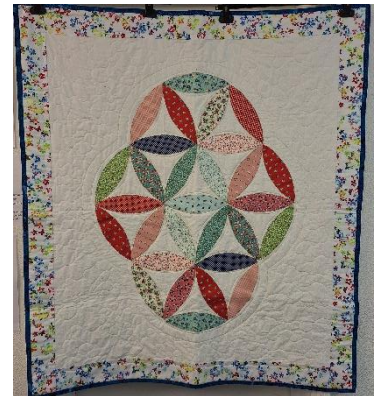
