



# Christmas Table Runner

## Sawtooth Star and Puss in Corner blocks



Approx. finished size: 42" by 19"

### **Fabrics requirements:**

3 larger picture panels from Stof panel  
FQ each of Green, Red and Cream fabrics  
1<sup>st</sup> border fabric 25cm  
2<sup>nd</sup> red border fabric 30 cm

### **Workshop Notes**

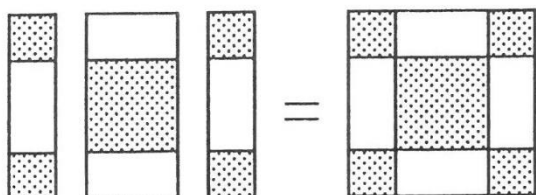
Cut all the picture panels out accurately to 6 ½" square

### **Puss in the corner block: - make 1**

Cut 4 rectangles 3 ½" x 6 ½" from the cream fabric and 4 squares at 3 ½" from the green fabric

Add one cream rectangle above the picture and another below

Create the sides by adding the green squares to the top and bottom of the other two cream rectangles and then add them to the centre piece.



### Sawtooth Star block: - make 2

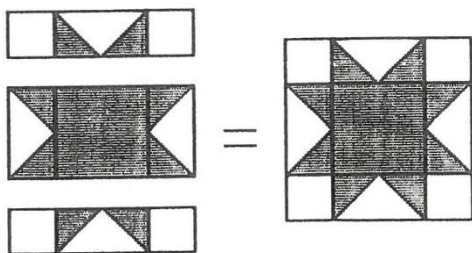
For each block, create 8 half square triangle units from red and cream using your favourite method, they need to be 3" finished (Thangles work well for this with no wastage).

Cut 4 squares from the cream fabric at 3 1/2" for the corners

Join the half square triangles together to form the flying goose unit – you will have 4 per block

Add one to each side of your picture panel and then add the cream squares to either end of the other two units.

Assemble as per diagram below.



Press all three blocks. Create the table runner by sewing the three blocks together (make sure your picture panels all face in the same direction!)

Add 2 borders:

The first border is in cream – which is cut 2" wide – add top and bottom and then the sides.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> border is cut 2 1/2" - add in the same sequence.

Layer quilt and bind

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
