

Christmas Table Runner Stoff Panel with Crossroad Sashing



Approx. finished size: 39" by 21" By Valerie Nesbitt

Fabrics requirements:

10 small squares from the panel

3 fabrics - red/cream/green 25 cm of each (FQ would work except for the red which is used in the 1^{st} border)

2nd border 30cm

Workshop Notes

Cut out 10 small squares accurately with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Add strip of red fabric which has been cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide to the top and bottom and down both sides – press and trim back to an accurate $\frac{4}{2}$ "



Using two colours – cream and green, cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of fabric and then subcut these into squares – you will need a total of 36 in each colour.

Take 15 of each colour and sew them together into pairs – one of each colour per pair.

Lay the picture squares out in a pleasing manner 2 x 5 and then place the sashing pairs (from the previous step) down following the pictures and creating 5 rows. Sew into place and press seams to the left.

Make 6 horizontal sashing rows using the remaining squares as per the picture – you will need three rows of 2x cream 3x green, 2x cream and three rows of 2x green, 3x cream, 2x green. Press seams to the right.

Sew these into place between the rows as shown in the picture at the top of these notes, making sure to match and nest the seams. Press well.

Add 2 borders – The 1^{st} red border is cut at $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ", add to the top and bottom and then the two sides. The 2^{nd} border is cut at $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " – add in the same order.

Layer, quilt and bind.

DESIGN OPTION: You could replace 18 of the above squares in the sashing rows with a third colour i.e. Red which would make it look like this:



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
