



## Nautical Star Two Block Quilt



Approx. finished size: 38" by 46"

### **Fabrics requirements:**

Background cream for quilt 75cm  
Colour fabric for Star (including centre square) 50cm  
Colour fabric for Puss in the Corner block – 25cm  
Border One – including cornerstones for border 2 – 50 cm  
Border Two – 75cm

### **Workshop Notes**

The star is a traditional sawtooth 8 pointed star and the other block is the simple Puss in the Corner block that has often been used in the Bed of Roses quilt.

### **Sawtooth Star block – Make 6**

Centre Square - cut 4.5"

Make 8 half square triangles with your favourite method – 2" finished with background and feature fabric (2" triangles make life easy as you can make them from the 2.5" strip of fabric that you are using for the corners)

Cut four corner squares from background fabric @ 2 ½"



## Puss in the Corner block – Make 6

From fabric 1:

Cut centre square at 4.5"

Cut 4 corner squares at 2.5

From fabric 2:

Cut 4 rectangles 2.5 x 4.5"



Lay the blocks out as per the picture below with 3 blocks in each row, and sew together in rows.



Add two borders:

The first border is cut at 2 ½" and sewn to the top and bottom of the quilt first and then the two sides.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> border is cut at 6" with 6" corner stones from the fabric used in border one.

Layer, quilt and bind.

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
