



# Tessellating Star Runner



Approx. finished size: 12" by 32"

## **Fabrics requirements:**

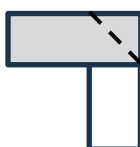
One strip of 2" x 40" per star  
Background – ½ m for project  
Binding: 6" (20cm)

## **Cutting Instructions**

For each star block you will need to cut:  
Star fabric: four pieces 2"x5" and four pieces 2" x 3.5"  
Background fabric: four pieces 2" x 5" and four pieces 2" x 3.5"

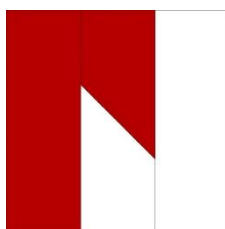
## **Workshop Notes**

Taking the short pieces of background and star fabric, sew together as per diagram



Cut off excess, open up and press seams

Lay out, adding a strip of background to right hand side and a strip of star fabric to left hand side as per diagram, sew together and press seams.



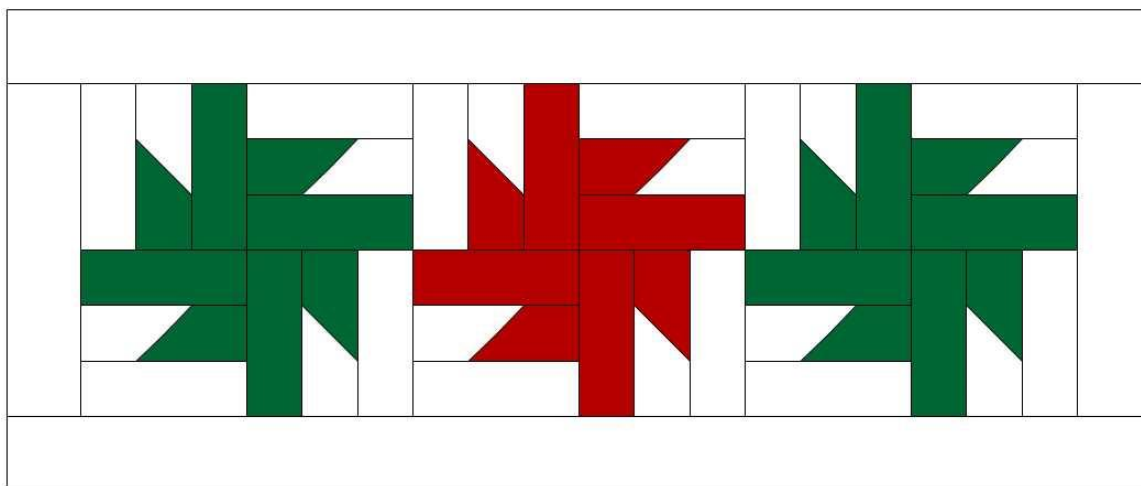
Repeat 3 times, so you have four pieces, sew these together as you would a 4 patch to create the star.

Make 3 stars.

Press and measure - X (approx 9.5")

Add sashing between them cut 2" wide by your star size (X from above) and to the top, bottom and sides of the runner.

*Note – the diagram below does not show sashing between the star blocks.*



Press well then layer quilt and bind.

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
