Class Description:

Do you have a pile of scraps you've cut into 2½" squares but not sure what to do with them? Why not bring them along and make a quilt! Both of these are based on using blocks of 16 at a time and Emma will show you how to make the extras for the quilts.

Fabric Requirements

- 1.2m background fabrics
- At least 200 2 ½" squares in a selection of colours / patterns. If you don't already have 2 ½" squares in your stash boxes just bring lots of scraps that are more than 2 ½" wide, ideally sorted into colours.
- For applique flowers you will also need 20x 5" scrap squares and 2 FQ of green fabrics, plus 1m of HeatnBond.

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet (a ¼" foot option is important), bobbins, needles plus your manual. (Yes, power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!)
- Thread for piecing (neutral colours are best)
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- A 2.5" by 12.5" ruler (if you have one) or any other small rulers (less than 6.5" by 6.5" is great)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
