

STACK & WHACK AND KALEIDOSCOPES

WITH EMMA RANDALL

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Class Description:

Lots of different images come up when searching for Kaleidoscope Quilts along with lots of different names! If you have wanted to make an optical illusions style quilt resembling the kaleidoscope pictures you remember from your childhood toy, then come along to this class and find out the different ways in which to make one. You will be using either 6 fabric repeats with hexagons, or 4 fabric repeats with squares or rectangles to create some stunning patterns.

Fabric Requirements

6 repeats of a large print fabric: e.g.

- if your fabric repeat is 6" you will need 36" of fabric
- if your fabric repeat is 8" you will need 48" of fabric
- if your fabric repeat is 12" you will need 72" of fabric.

You will also need 1m of fabric for setting and sashing.

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 8 sewing machines (Janome DXL 603) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible (including a travel mug if you have one).
